

## Vimy and the Somme:

After we pick you up at your hotel we drive to Vimy where we visit the site.  
We continue South drive along the front Line of 1<sup>st</sup> July 1916 and visit places like Beaumont Hamel and the New Foundland memorial. In Thiepval we visit the memorial to the missing.  
We discover the Lochnagar crater

In Becordel Becourt we visit the British cemetery where oldest known British soldier to die in the First World War is buried and also where a father and son who died in the same conflict are buried side by side.

In Fricourt we visit the German cemetery where the Red Baron was buried.  
And in Mametz Wood we discover the memorial for the 38<sup>th</sup> Welch division.

On the way back we drive through Pozieres, Courcelette, Flers, Montauban, Bernafay Wood, Delville Wood, Bazentin and Bapaume.  
The guide will stop at some interesting locations.

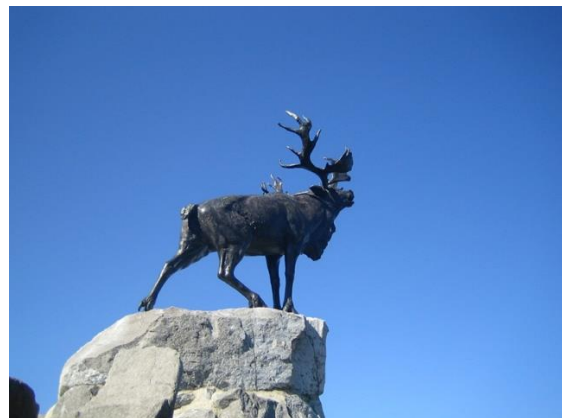
The Somme is a big area and it is possible to visit other sites.
